



Annexure B

Schedule 1 (Code of Conduct for Councillors) of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000:

- 1.1. In terms of Schedule 1 (Code of Conduct for Councilors) of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 and particularly section 14 (1)(a) (Breaches of Code), a Municipal Council may investigate and make a finding of any alleged breach of a provision of the code.
 - 1.2. In terms of Schedule 1 (Code of Conduct for Councilors) of the Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 and particularly section 14 (1)(b) (Breaches of Code) a Municipal Council may establish **a special committee to:**
 - (i) Investigate and make a finding on any alleged breach of this Code; and
 - (ii) To make appropriate recommendations to Council.
 - 1.3. Section 13 of Schedule 1 of the Code imposes a duty on the Chairperson of Council to authorize an investigation if, on reasonable suspicion, he is of the opinion that a provision of this code has been breached. The Chairperson must give the Councillor a reasonable opportunity to reply in writing to the alleged breach and report the matter to a meeting of Council.
 - 1.4. The remaining provisions of section 14 deal with what a Council may do if it is found that a Councillor has breached a provision of this Code.
